 - CIS 240 Networking Concepts (3) *prerequisite: CIS 101 or permission of instructor*
 - CIS 330 Systems Analysis (3) *prerequisite: BUA/CIS 303*
 - Complete any programming elective (3)
 - Complete any upper-level (300-400) Computer Information Systems elective (3)
