 - ISS 210 Introduction to Information Systems Security (3) *prerequisite: CIS 101*
 - ISS 220 Security Risk Management and Policy (3) *prerequisite: ISS 210 or concurrent enrollment*
 - ISS 410 Cyber Security I (3) *prerequisite: ISS 210 and CIS 240*
 - ISS 470 Information Systems Security Management (3) *prerequisite: ISS 220 & 410*
