

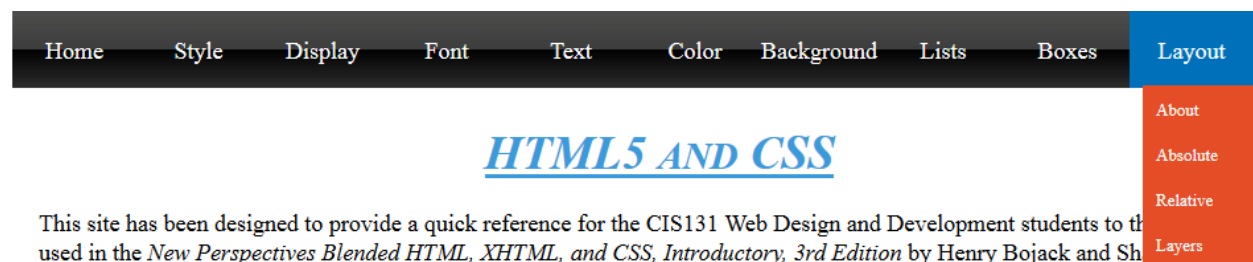

**58 x 1 px high background image for the submenu (gradient)**

### CREATING AN HTML LIST

Most horizontal or vertical navigation bars begin with a simple unordered list `<ul>` tag and the hyperlinks as list items `<li>` tags.

**Step 1:** In a text editor, create an html file with the `<html>`, `<head>`, `<title>`, `</title>`, `</head>`, `<body>`, `</body>`, and `</html>` tags and

save as `horizontal_navigation_bar.html` in the `PortableApps/GIMP/menus/dropdown` folder.

**Step 2:** Between the beginning and ending `<body>` tags, type

Notice how the main menu item has a class of “top” and the submenu items have a class of “item”.

**Step 3:** Save and view in the browser.



## STYLING THE UNORDERED LIST WITH A CASCADING STYLE SHEET

Next we will create our CSS Style Sheet.

**Step 1:** Create a new document and add the following information, including the comments then save it as ‘css\_tutorial\_styles.css’.

If you want to see the syntax highlighting as you type, select Language | C | CSS

**Step 2:** Add the styles on this and the next page to format the display of the menu

Older versions of I.E. have problem with being able to select the whole button. To solve the problem in I.E. you will want to add a style section in the head of the document that sets another style if the browser is I.E.

**Step 3:** Upload the background image for the menu bar: 'css\_btn.png' to the menus/dropdown folder. This image is available in at the Design tab of the GIMP site.



If the font drops to two lines on the submenu, you can change the font to 12 pixels

You may want to change the padding in the #menu ul:hover .item a style to 3px so the submenu will be wide enough.

/*sets the height of the submenu by adding padding above and below the link text */

**Step 4:** Insert the following code in the index.html file to link to the css\_tutorial\_styles.css file.

```
<head>
<meta http-equiv="content-type" content="text/html; charset=utf-8" />
<link href = "css/css_tutorial_styles.css" rel = "stylesheet" type = "text/css" />
<title>Cascading Style Sheet Tutorial</title>
```

Save the file and upload to the server. Test in the browser.
