## WEB 2.0 MENUS: HORIZONTAL NAVIGATION BAR WITH BUTTON IMAGE

Sometimes instead of a solid color dynamic button, the button is two images – a default button and a hover button. For this tutorial, you will need `sunflower_btn_dark_04_27_11.png` and `sunflower_btn_light_04_27_11.png` that you saved in your `PortableApps/GIMP/buttons/images` folder at the Buttons tab.

**Step 1:** In a text editor, open `horizontal_navigation_bar.html` from the `PortableApps/GIMP/menus/` folder.
